## Event Report

### SUMMARY OF EVENT

Overall the event went smoothly.

There was one incident of possible cheating, however, it was corrected before it actually occurred. SASPD girls had suited up and intended to play 17 players on the final day. The matter was resolved before kick off to avoid game implications.

The coaches displayed flexibility and willingness to help out. I appreciate their support. Overall, they were a great group of people to work with.
